

## Candle Care Guide

Caring for your candle helps ensure a cleaner, longer-lasting burn and a better overall experience. With a few simple steps, you can enjoy your candle safely and consistently from first light to last.



During the **first burn**, allow the wax to melt fully to the edges of the container. This helps to **prevent tunneling** and promote an even burn over time. Limit burn sessions to **3–4 hours at a time** to preserve quality and extend the longevity of the fragrance.



The wick should be **trimmed to ¼ inch** before each use to maintain a clean flame and reduce smoke. Keep the wax **surface free from debris** and wick trimmings. When finished burning, use a snuffer or **gently blow** out the flame to extinguish.



Always place your candle on a **level, heat-safe surface**, away from drafts, vents, and direct sunlight. **Keep candles away** from flammable materials, loose hair or clothing, and out of reach of children and pets. **Never leave** a burning candle unattended.



Discontinue use when **approximately ½ inch of wax** remains at the bottom of the container. Any remaining wax can be removed by adding **hot water** to the container, allowing it to release and float to the top. **Do not burn** in damaged vessels.
